And I like it!   















I had forgotten how much he puts me on the edge of my seat!</p> <p>About recording the show, Sony makes a dual record cassette deck that records 4 hours of continuous recording if you use two 120 min tapes! I just bought one to record the show, and used it last nite for the first time. Worked great. These are being discontinued, so I was able to get it at a close out price of \$159 at Best Buy (mine was a demo).
