I once worked with a small theater group called Creative Kaos - acting, stunts & special effects. My friends and I had a strange job - we got paid to shoot at each other. I have done 30-foot high falls, 3 car rollovers, and a half-body burn.:embarrassed: We were hired to do a wild west shoot-out & bar fight show for the 1992 Republican Convention, held at the AstroDome complex. (we performed in the upstairs hall of the AstoHall) We were walking the convention floor, carrying loaded .36cal cap&ball pistols on our hips(with blanks, of course. but even blanks can be lethal.) My partner I was walking with jerked his thumb and asked,"is that who I think it is?" There was Ted, standing tall inhis fringed buckskin jacket. We walked over, and I shook his hand and asked,"Ted, would autograph my pistol?"

"Whip that puppy out." he said, and scrawled his name across the right side of the wooden handgrip. He was a very pleasant, and kinda laidback, guy. Straight up. I've seen him perform 5 times. In 1991,

onstage at Houston's Woodlands Pavilion with the band Damn Yankees. (great CD if you can find it) Using a compound bow, he sank two, slightly uphill, perfect heart-shots on a life-size Saddam Hussein target at 42 yards! I know that, because I worked at the pavilion, on the post-show clean-up crew. We measured the distance. Way kewl!
